

COHA COVID GUIDELINES as of April 17 2022

My Vaccine Passes are no longer mandated and will not be required for players, coaches, or officials.

Outdoor Setting.

There are no capacity limits for outdoor gatherings.

There are no requirements for physical distancing while playing, participating or spectating at any level of the Covid-19 Protection Framework – Green, Orange and Red.

Indoor Setting

Indoors Gatherings can have up to 200 people based on allowing 1 metre of space per person.

Masks should be worn in common areas or facilities accessed by gatherings (like shared toilets and the pavilion)

There is no requirement to scan in or for a business to display a QR code poster or have mandatory record keeping.

How will these guidelines work?

• Masks need to be worn when accessing the indoor facilities such as the bathrooms and the

pavilion. They are not required outdoors.

- Particular attention to regular cleaning of equipment and surfaces.
- If a senior team is unable to play due to 5 players sick with COVID the points will be allocated as a draw.
- If unwell stay at home and get tested if you have COVID-19 symptoms.
