COACHING COURSE

Coaches thank you very much for participating in the coaching courses. Here some take-aways:

- Remember that being a good sports coach is an ongoing process of learning, adapting, and refining your coaching approach to meet the needs of your hockey players.
- Understanding the sport: You don't have to be a top hockey player to be a good coach. Make sure you understand what you want to teach the players. That you understand the games you are going to play. Preparation is key here! Plan out your sessions.
- Short Fun and play-oriented activities: Create different challenges, small groups, multiple activities (stations), kids love to achieve something, so facilitate selfchallenges and remember learning is messy (maximise time, no lines, no lectures).
- Break activities and skills down: For example, play Rob the Nest first running without a stick, then dribbling with a stick and a ball, and then in pairs with passes. Or break a skill down with 3 steps: Step, Push, Point. Or Step, Hitt, Point etc.






